CERTIFICATE OF VALUATION (OIL BUNKERS AND LUBRICATING OILS)

This is to certify that at the request of The Sheriff's Office, the undersigned ship appraiser to SEAWISE Maritime Services has examined the oil bunkers and lubricating oil quantity on board the steel built, twin screw, double hull, oil tanker,

BRIGHTOIL 326

IMO 9760861 of Singapore

whilst the vessel lay afloat to her port anchor at Eastern Special Purpose Anchorage (AESP), Singapore on 9th August 2019 for the purpose of conducting an Appraisal of the oil bunker and lubricating oil quantity on board the vessel and thereby valuing oil bunkers and lubricating oil remaining on board.

From the result of our survey, the following oil bunker and lubricating oil quantities were ascertained to be remaining on board on the 9th August 2019.

- Heavy Fuel Oil (380 cst) **19.232 M/tons**
- Marine Diesel Oil **22.343 M/tons**

Lubricating Oil:

- G.E System oil **510 Litres**
- M.E. System oil **1,197 Litres**
